

Car Insurance

California law requires all owners and drivers of motor vehicles to have car insurance. If you have an accident and do not have the necessary auto insurance your license will be suspended. You can also be fined \$1,350 if you do not have proof of auto insurance when driving a motor vehicle.

California law states that drivers must have insurance to cover:

- \$15,000 for a single death or injury.
- \$30,000 for a death or injury to more than one person.
- \$5,000 for property damage.



Never operate any motor vehicle without enough automobile liability insurance.
